Pastor: This is the table of the Lord and belongs to no individual, church or denomination and is open to all people who wish to come closer to God shown to us in Jesus the Christ.

Pastor: Come to this table, not because you must, but because you may; not because you are strong, but because you stand in need of God's love, mercy and assurance. Come not to express an opinion, but to seek a presence and to pray for a spirit. Come, not because any goodness of your own gives you a right to come, but because you need mercy and help. Come, because you love the Lord a little and would like to love him more. Come, because he loved you and gave himself for you. Come and meet the risen Christ, for we are his Body. Come to this table as you are.

All: We come to the table that is spread for you and me that we might again know that God has come to us, shared our common lot, and invited us to be renewed and strengthened in our common mission to share God's love.

Communion Prayer

Pastor: God be with you. **People: And also with you.**

Pastor: Lift up your hearts. **People: We lift them to God.**

Pastor: Let us give thanks to the God of mercy.

People: It is right to give God thanks and praise.

Pastor: It is right, and a good and joyful thing, always and everywhere to give thanks to you, almighty God, creator of heaven and earth. You formed us in your image and breathed into us the breath of life. When we turned away, and our love failed, your love remained steadfast. You delivered us from captivity, made covenant to be our sovereign God, and spoke to us through the prophets. All: Holy, holy, holy God of love and majesty, the whole universe speaks of your glory, O God Most High.

Through his teaching and his actions, he demonstrated that the time had come when you would save your people. When he processed into Jerusalem on a colt, the people gathered and cried, "Hosanna! Save us!" because he lived your salvific love in our midst. And as the enthusiasm of "Hosanna!" began to dim in the shadow of plots to crucify him, he did not waver in the love and grace he extended to all.

Words of Institution

Drink this, for it is the blood of Christ, shed for you.
