First Congregational United Church of Christ of Alpena invites <u>non-profit agencies and organizations</u> to apply for grants from our Comstock Fund. The Comstock Fund supports programs that render service to all people and strives for righteousness, justice, compassion, and peace.

Comstock Grant Application Check List

- Submit the application in paper form (or via email) to First Congregational United Church of Christ by the deadline of October 1st. Applications must be <u>received</u> (not postmarked) no later than October 1st. We are not responsible for mailing delays.
- Use original form, or, if creating your own form, follow, precisely, the format of the original form. (Call the Church office 989 356-1795 to have a Microsoft Word file emailed to you.)
- Make sure the application has appropriate signatures.
- Clearly state the non-profit organization or agency for which the application is being submitted.
- State project objectives clearly. Additional pages may be necessary and may be attached.
- If possible, show how project objectives may be measured.
- Be certain that proposed objectives can be achieved within the one-year time allotment.
- If you are awarded a grant, you will receive a "Funds Request Form" with your notification letter. You must return the "Funds Request Form" to actually receive your grant funds.
- The "Recipient Report Form" must be filed by June 30th to qualify for a grant application the following year.

Please keep in mind:

- Grants greater than \$10,000 have never been awarded to an outside organization.
- Rarely have awarded grants exceeded \$5,000.
- "Bricks and mortar" grants are seldom awarded.
