## What is an Intentional Interim Minister?

Defined by the United Church of Christ there are three forms of ministry during the interim time:

## Transition (Intentional Interim) Minister:

Provides for the worship life of the congregation, basic pastoral care and leadership and helps to guide a church through unique complexities, challenges and opportunities inherent during an interim time, by working to create an atmosphere that brings about and/or sustains congregational health while allowing time for the search and call process to unfold in an non-anxious and intentional manner. A successful transition ministry during an interim time requires mutual expectation, purpose, and direction, between the congregation, the conference/association staff and the transition minister. The Transitional Ministry is a specialized ministry designed to bring specific skills and experience to help a congregation deal with instances such as conflict, breach of ethics, and unusually long pastorate, when a previously called minister remains part of the congregation and/or remains part of the congregation and community after retirement. The transition minister sees this ministry as a vocation and has specialized training and experience.

## Sustaining:

A sustaining (interim) minister, like a transitional minister, provides for the worship life of the congregation and works with the committees and board. By providing full ministerial service, a sustaining minister frees up the lay leadership to focus on the congregational profile and other search related activities. A sustaining minister may or may not see this form of specialized ministry as a vocation. While the sustaining minister may or may not have benefitted from specialized training they often make excellent use of life experiences, inherent skills and abilities, used to keep a congregation focused on unique opportunities and challenges during this time of transition.

## Interim Supply Minister.

This minister differs from a pulpit supply minister, it fulfills a vital role which provides some, but not all, of the essentials of pastoral and worship life during the time of transition.

\*\*According to the document titled Interim Ministry taken from the United Church of Christ guidelines, adopted at 17th General Synod, 1989 and United Church of Christ Committee on Ministry, Publishes 2005 Parish Life and Leadership.

During our three year interim period we have experienced two different types of ministers; Pulpit Supply Ministers, part-time Interim Supply Ministers (which we call Transitional Minister and now we will begin with a new Transition (Intentional Interim) Minister.
