With so much concern and emotion being focused on **global climate change**, the spread of **disease** among human societies, and the **impact** that humans have on our planet, several of our church members (Rev. Gene Bacon, Dr. Avery Aten, Marcia Aten, Edith Gerber, Terry Bell, and I) have been learning about **how our "eco-system" is evolving & affecting our bodies**.

We live in a shared habitat on a dynamic planet. The science of **ecology** studies the structure of living communities and how they interact and evolve. Here are the topics, each session will have two 30-minute lectures:

Sept. 3 – The Co-Evolution of Human Diseases *(very relevant to the current pandemic!)*
and **Strategies for Reversing Ecosystem Decline** *(we will only begin this topic)*

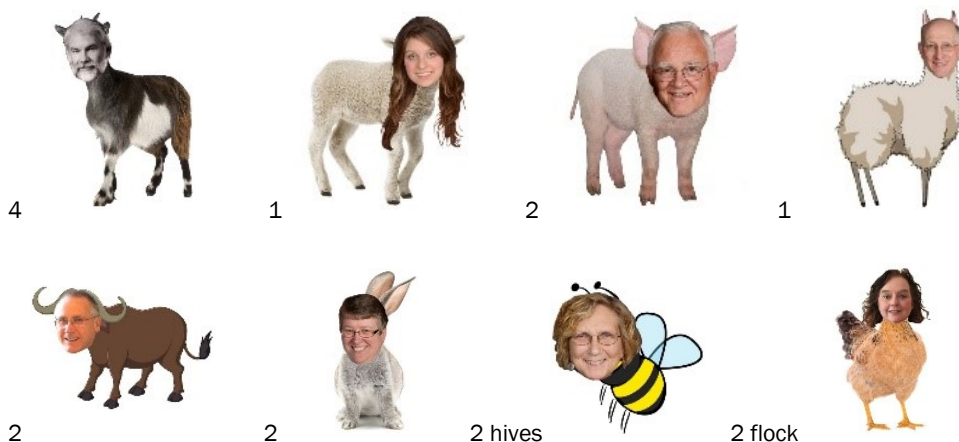
Sept. 10 – More Strategies for Reversing Ecosystem Decline *(continued from Sept. 3)*
