With so much concern and emotion being focused on *global climate change*, the spread of *disease* among human societies, and the *impact* that humans have on our planet, several of our church members (Rev. Gene Bacon, Dr. Avery Aten, Marcia Aten, Edith Gerber, Terry Bell, and I) have been learning about how our "eco-system" is evolving & affecting our bodies.

We live in a shared habitat on a dynamic planet. The science of **ecology** studies the structure of living communities and how they interact and evolve. Here are the topics, each session will have <u>two 30-minute lectures</u>:

Sept. 3 – The Co-Evolution of Human Diseases (very relevant to the current pandemic!) and Strategies for Reversing Ecosystem Decline (we will only begin this topic)


Sept. 10 – More Strategies for Reversing Ecosystem Decline (continued from Sept. 3) and Sustainable Urban Ecosystems
